Camfed and Pearson launch partnership for girls' education

Pearson are delighted to announce a pioneering new partnership between Camfed and Pearson to transform educational opportunities for girls in Zimbabwe and Tanzania.

The Camfed-Pearson partnership has been awarded a grant under the prestigious Girls' Education Challenge, launched by the UK's Department for International Development to give one million of the world's poorest girls the chance to improve their lives through education.

This partnership will enable 60,000 vulnerable girls in Zimbabwe and Tanzania to enrol in secondary school, benefit more than 400,000 children through action to improve their learning, and create new opportunities for young people in the poorest rural communities.
